

## Medical Conditions Checklist Philippines

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### Profile of Children from the Philippines

Children referred through the standard program are typically healthy and developmentally on track, or with very mild delays. Children may also have minor/correctable conditions or birth parent background issues. Older children (age 6+) are typically matched through Special Home Finding and are often healthy and developmentally on track, though some children may be behind academically, have emotional issues related to a difficult past or trauma, etc.

**Age:** Between 12 months to 15 years.

**Gender:** Families must be open to the referral of a child of either gender, and cannot decline a referral based on the child's gender. Families can state a gender preference, but we cannot guarantee that the child match will be of the preferred gender.

The following are common medical conditions seen in many referred children. Please mark all that you are open to:

- Exposure to alcohol or tobacco in utero
- Exposure to drugs in utero
- Birth parent has a medical condition
- Birth parent has a mental health condition
- Prematurity (less than 36 weeks gestation)
- Low birth weight (less than 4.5lbs)
- Mild developmental delays
- Minor skin conditions
- Minor vision impairment
- Minor hearing impairment

We also receive referrals through Special Home Finding. Please indicate what you are open to (if any):

- Older children (ages 6+)
- Part of an older sibling group (ages 8+)
- More involved medical or developmental need (please list)
