Profile of Children from Vietnam

As of 12/31/20, the Vietnam program is no longer a "Special Needs" only program, as families can now be matched with children under age 5 who have only minor special needs. We still ask families to be as open as possible to child profile, and adoptive families open to moderate-major special needs may be matched faster.

Age: 12 months to 5 years; older children 6+ years.

Gender: Families can choose to adopt a child of a particular gender if they are open to an older child age 6+, but due to the nature of this small program, families should be as open as possible to the child profile they are open to, including gender.
